Title: Procedure for Sample Collection: Mycoplasma testing

**Objective:** To retain samples representative of the pullets on delivery to allow subsequent PCR test for Mycoplasma if they go Positive on blood testing.

**Materials required:** Dry, cotton-tipped, plastic stemmed swabs, Grip-seal sample bag, disposable gloves.

## Method:

- 1. Obtain the required sampling materials from Poultry Health Services.
- 2. Wash hands.
- 3. Put on a pair of disposable gloves.
- 4. Complete the submission form, ensuring to include the business, farm name, age of birds, house number and date of sampling.
- 5. Swab 6 birds in each house by introducing the swab into the cleft (photo 1) in the upper part of the mouth (photo 2)





- 6. Split the 6 swabs into 2 bags (3 swabs per bag). Put the 2 bags into the bigger bag, with the house number.
- 7. Repeat the above for each house.
- 8. Put all the bags in the envelope addressed to Liverpool do not forget to include the submission form.
- 9. Take the samples to the post office and post them on the day of sampling. If this is not possible, keep the samples in the fridge until the following day.

## For all samples:

Plan for samples to arrive on a weekday.

Use appropriate sample numbers and containers – consult the Laboratory or supervising vet if in any doubt.

Package in a secure leakproof manner and submit on the day of sampling. If not possible, please keep samples refrigerated (not frozen)



Complete the submission form and place separately to the samples.
